## 1. RULES

- 1.1. The race will be governed by rules as defined in The 2017 – 2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) of World Sailing, and the Prescriptions of Australian Sailing.
- 1.2. RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 1.3. If there is a conflict between the Sailing Instructions and the Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail, this changes RRS 63.7

## 2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. Boats and competitors shall comply with World Sailing Regulation 20, Advertising Code.
- 2.2. Boats and competitors may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

## 3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1. The King of Carnac is open to Kites, Windsurfers, and Off the Beach Catamarans. Other Off the Beach Sailing classes may be included by application.
- 3.2. Participants shall apply to compete at the Event by completing the online application form and a Participant Disclaimer.
- 3.3. Entries will only be accepted from a current financial member of;
  - 3.3.1. a yacht club affiliated with Australian Sailing and have a valid Australian Sailing Sailor Identification Number, OR,
  - 3.3.2. PKR affiliated club of WAKSA in good standing with the KA
  - 3.3.3. WWA the State Windsurfing Association
- 3.4. Proof of such registration may be requested on the day of the race and at the Organiser's discretion.
- 3.5. International participants are actively encouraged to enter and may enter with a valid membership of their national kite or sailing association as recognised by AS.
- 3.6. All safety gear for Windsurfers and Kiteboarders required as per Department of Transport rules for 2-5 nautical miles and as defined by the Organiser (<http://www.transport.wa.gov.au/imagine/kite-and-windsurfing-safe.asp>)
- 3.7. Windsurfers & Kites
  - 3.7.1. PFD - Required
  - 3.7.2. PLB - Required
  - 3.7.3. 2 red or 2 orange flares - Required
  - 3.7.4. Helmet – Recommended
  - 3.7.5. Hydration Camel Pack – Recommended

- 3.8. Kite Class Equipment Limitation
  - 3.8.1. Only Formula or Hydro-foil boards will be permitted.
- 3.9. Windsurf Class Equipment Limitation
  - 3.9.1. Only Formula, Windfoil, RSX, Raceboard or similar that can easily manage a windward/leeward in light winds.
- 3.10. Catamaran Class
  - 3.10.1. All boats must carry a Tow rope of at least 15m of minimum 6mm diameter
  - 3.10.2. Open to off the beach catamarans with a current AS Yardstick under 90
  - 3.10.3. Off the beach catamarans without current AS Yardstick can apply to the organisers for acceptance of entry
  - 3.10.4. All Catamarans & other off the beach boats will need to provide a completed [Australian Sailing 2017-2021 AS Special Regulations Part 2 Equipment Audit Form \(Off the Beach\)](#) and proof of insurance at registration - spot checks will be done
- 3.11. Participants must provide their own safety equipment, the Organiser reserves the right to inspect and reject any equipment a Participant proposes to use, at their complete discretion.
- 3.12. The Organiser reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including an entrant's identity, age and place of residence) and to disqualify any entrant who submits an entry that is not in accordance with this Notice of Race or who tampers with the entry process.

## 4. FEES

- 4.1. The entry fee of \$70 is payable to the Organiser to secure participation in the Event.
- 4.2. Additional Optional Extras: Participants may purchase at time of online entry;
  - 4.2.1. Limited Edition Polo Shirt (only available as pre-purchase).
- 4.3. Entry fees are non-refundable.

## 5. ENTRIES

- 5.1. Entries Open: 1st October 2019
- 5.2. Entries Close: 11pm 1st November 2019

- 5.4. Substitution of competitors only by approval of the Organisers.
- 5.5. Medical withdrawals must be advised prior to Registrations Check opening on the morning of the event.

## 5.6. SCHEDULE

5.7. Registration & Safety Gear Check: 9:00am – 10.15am,

5.7.1. Participants are expected to complete registration and a Participant Disclaimer at this time.

5.8. COMPULSORY Race Briefing: 10:30am.

5.9. First warning signal will be no earlier than 11.30am.

5.10. Up to three separate races may be held on the day.

5.11. Sunday the club will host W-L racing including a leg of the WA F18 Traveller Series. Sunday racing is not part of the KOC event, but competitors are welcome to stay on for this racing. More details on the club's Facebook page, registrations at the club prior to racing, fees apply for overnight stays, bar will be open.

## 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. Sailing Instructions will be available prior to race day and copies will also be available on the notice board.

6.2. Any changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the notice board.

6.3. The Organiser may disqualify any participant that does not comply with these Competition Rules and Conditions of Entry, or does not attend the COMPULSORY race briefing.

6.4. It is a condition of entry into the Event that all participants sign on the day of competition a release of liability in the form provided by the Organiser (Participant Disclaimer).

6.5. All competitors will ensure prompt sign off once they leave the launching/landing area.

## 7. RACING AREA

7.1. Attachment A shows the proposed location of the racing area in Owen Anchorage.

## 8. SCORING

8.1. The Low point system of Appendix A will apply.

8.2. In the case of a draw on points: fastest total accumulated time across all races will be used. This changes RRS A8.1

8.3. Catamaran Class winners will be calculated on latest Australian Sailing Yardstick.

## 9. PRIZES

9.1. Trophies will be presented to 1st, 2nd, 3rd for each class, and for Event Overall Winner.

## **10. RIGHTS**

- 10.1. The Winners agree to participate in any news media activities surrounding the Event. It is a condition of entry that all Participants agree to their image and/or voice, and likeness as recorded, photographed or filmed during the Event (including but not limited to as part of the Event), may be broadcast or published by the Organiser or its related entities worldwide in any media, including but not limited to television, radio, internet, newspapers, magazines, or any other advertising, marketing or publicity purposes in connection with the Event or any future event in perpetuity and throughout the world without additional compensation or further consent being obtained.

## **11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

- 11.1. Participants acknowledge that the Event is potentially a dangerous activity that may result in injury or death, and participate at their own risk. Participants must:
- 11.1.1. attend, undergo and pass any appropriate training, briefings, required medical tests and other requirements of the Organiser and event organisers as determined by them in their absolute discretion;
  - 11.1.2. not have any medical conditions that would make it dangerous to participate in the event;
  - 11.1.3. not be under the influence of drugs or alcohol;
  - 11.1.4. comply with all directions of the Organiser and event organisers at all times; and
  - 11.1.5. wear all safety and other equipment required at all times.
- 11.2. Participants categorically participate in the race entirely at their own risk.

## **12. GENERAL**

- 12.1. The Organiser and its partners accept no responsibility for lost, late, stolen, damaged or misdirected registrations.
- 12.2. If for any reason this Event is not capable of running as planned, the Organiser reserve the right in their discretion to modify the terms of the Event including the prizes and this Notice of Race.
- 12.3. Any cost associated with accessing the Event website is the Participants responsibility and is dependent on the internet service provider used.
- 12.4. The Organiser, in their absolute discretion, at all times reserve the right to:
- 12.4.1. prevent any Participant from participating in the Event if, at any time, they reasonably believe that the Participant poses a safety risk to themselves or others, or for any other reason, including but not limited to, acting in a manner which is likely to bring the Organiser into disrepute, or is likely to cause harm to participants, the Organiser employees, contractors or volunteers, or any other third party;

- 12.4.2. change the format of the Event for any reason including but not limited to weather, number of entries, time constraints or any unforeseen incidents; and
- 12.4.3. cancel the Event if the conditions are deemed dangerous or not suitable for the event to start or continue.
- 12.5. If the Event is varied for any reason beyond the control of the Organiser it may not be rescheduled.
- 12.6. All entries in the Event becomes the property of the Organiser, who collects this personal information in order to conduct the Event and may for this purpose, disclose such information to third parties. By entering this Event, unless otherwise advised by the Participant, each Participant consents to the Organiser using the Participants personal information to administer the Event, announce the winners and disclosing the Participants personal information to organisations that assist the Organiser with administering the Event, and to third parties as required by law (including authorities that regulate this Event).

## **13. INSURANCE**

- 13.1. Each Participant shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of AU \$10m per event or equivalent, or as required by class rules.
- 13.2. All competitors who submit an Entry Form are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover.

## **14. CANCELLATION**

- 14.1. The Organisers are entitled to cancel or postpone the event at any stage without liability for reasons beyond the reasonable control of the Organisers. In the event of such cancellation entry fees shall not be refunded.
- 14.2. In the event of cancellation by the Organiser for other reasons the Organiser may refund entry fees less a reasonable sum in respect of irrecoverable costs incurred by the Organiser but shall not otherwise be liable to participants.

## **15. THE ORGANISER**

- 15.1. The Organiser of the King of Carnac Event is Jervoise Bay Sailing Club. King of Carnac is supported by Perth Kite Racing & Windsurfing WA.
